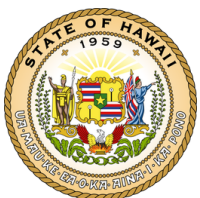


How To Setup Your Medical ID

- Step 1** Open the **Settings** app, scroll down, and tap **Safety and emergency**.
- Step 2** Tap **Medical info**.
- Step 3** Enter your medical information such as medications, allergies, and any conditions you may have. Tap **Save** when you are done. To continue editing other fields, tap the **edit/pencil icon** in the upper right corner.
- Step 4** To make your medical information readily available to emergency responders, go back to the **Safety and emergency** page, and tap **Emergency contacts**.
- Step 5** Turn on **Show on Lock screen**.
This will make your Medical ID available from the Lock screen. In an emergency, this gives information to people who want to help.
- Step 6** Turn on **Share during emergency calls and texts**.
When you make a call or send a text to emergency services on your Android phone, your Medical ID will automatically be shared with emergency services.

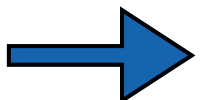
Best Practices for Medical ID

- Be concise. Avoid overly detailed, non-essential information.
- Check spelling. Double check medication names.
- Add multiple emergency contacts.
- Regularly update information, especially after doctor visits or other major life events.
- Inform your friends and family that you have a Medical ID.

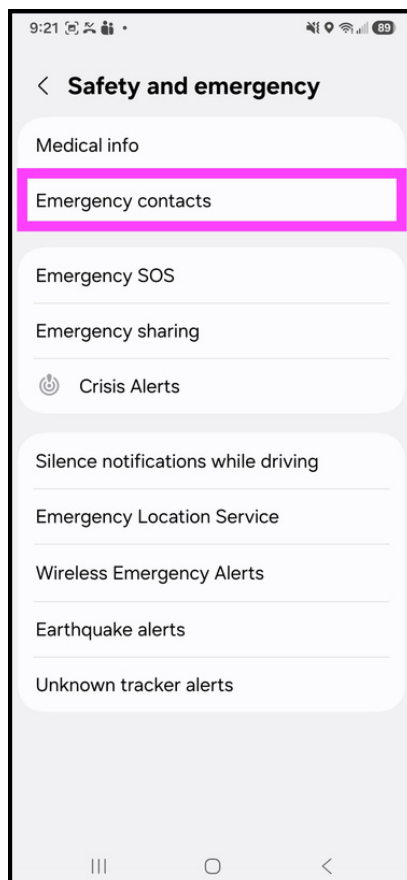
