SNAP/EBT Benefits

- Many people will get automatic replacement of 60% of August SNAP benefits.
- If you have lost income due to Hurricane Lowell, you may be eligible for SNAP benefits.

Transportation and Safety

Kaua'i Bus

- Buses are free
- Reduced schedule (usually every hour)
- Buses stop at food and refuge sites
- Expect delays
- Route info: [kauai.gov/Government/Departments-Agencies/Transportation](https://www.kauai.gov/Government/Departments-Agencies/Transportation)

Travel Safety - Please Limit Driving

- Only drive if you must
- Pull over and stop for emergency vehicles
- Do NOT follow police cars
- Do NOT enter closed roads
- Expect delays

Outdoor Safety

- Do not swim, hike, or surf right now
- Outdoor areas may be dangerous
- Emergency rescues may not be possible

Power and Generator Safety

Power

- Power may take some time to fully return
- Stay away from downed power lines
- Call 911 for dangerous lines
- KIUC paused bill collections
- KIUC outage map:

Generator safety

- Keep generators outside, 20 feet from your home, and far from doors/windows
- Never plug a generator into home outlets
- Let generator cool before refueling
