The Hawaii State Public Library System is pleased to offer free Wi-Fi access to cardholders in all [51 library branches](#).

Library users may access the Wi-Fi in the public service areas of the library during open hours with a valid HSPLS library card.

How do I use it?

1. Find Wi-Fi signal

Each device (tablet, laptop, smart phone, etc...) requires a slightly different process for connecting to Wi-Fi. Please follow the directions required by your device to identify and receive Wi-Fi signals, find your settings icon and locate "Wi-Fi" connections.

2. Locate our network, "HSPLS Public"

Once your device finds our HSPLS Public Wi-Fi network, you will need to enter your library card number and PIN number.

3. Agree to our terms

Next you will need to agree to the HSPLS [Internet acceptable use](#) and [wireless security disclaimer and use policies](#). Please be sure to read the policies, which describe appropriate usage in the library, as well as risks and benefits of using the service.

Please note that the Wi-Fi access is ended 15 minutes before the library closes, so be sure to save any work or processes that are online before this time.
